Bruns was responsible for the total realization of the exhibition, according to Kinkorn's design. The interior consists of various flagpoles, title boards with interactive screens, standing information boards with built-in display cases, converted PGU cabinets into display cases, graphic walls and projections.

The exhibition is developed in cooperation with design agency Kinkorn and the Marine Museum. The museum's wishes were turned into a fresh, tough, no-nonsense exhibition aligned with the standards and values of the Marines and of course the Marine Museum.

In the spirit of reusing, existing display cases, furniture and even hardware were used as much as possible. In the process, converting old steel PGU cabinets into display cases was the biggest challenge. In addition, aesthetically the exhibition was not to be too neat, but a little rough. Finding the right balance in this was a quest.

Netherlands Marines is an exhibition that truly typifies the character of the Marines: direct, ambitious, no-nonsense, hard, tough, humorous and sympathetic.
