Van Gogh in Brabant



North-Brabant is the birthplace of Dutch painter Vincent van Gogh (1835 – 1890), one of the most famous painters in the world. In the new exhibition Van Gogh in Brabant, you will discover the strong connection he had with this province. He was born in Zundert and lived in various places in Brabant. The exhibition presents twelve art pieces by Van Gogh as well as letters, personal documents, photographs, animations and other objects.

Het Noordbrabants Museum is the only museum location in the south of the Netherlands where original works by the painter are kept. The presentation shows the various developments of van Gogh. The most important themes from his Brabant period are highlighted: the rural environment, peasant life and still life. In North-Brabant he took his first steps toward becoming an artist. He never lost his love for Brabant and its landscape during his life.

Bruns has been fully responsible for the realization of the exhibition Van Gogh in Brabant, designed by Studio Berry Slok. High-quality showcases, displays and graphics were expertly executed and applied in the room. The mounting of the collection pieces to be presented was examined in detail. For example, how a specific piece can stand upright such as a letter on acid-free cardboard. Each type of collection like a dairy, book, print, photo, letter or object has its own designed mount in the correct size.

Various pieces of furniture and showcases of the exhibition were developed, engineered, produced and installed on site. The furniture was painted in specific color codes. In addition, graphics were carefully applied in vinyl and the screen printing techniques was used. Finally, in cooperation with Ata Tech, the collection in the showcases has been perfectly highlighted. Everything is realized in a short lead time.
