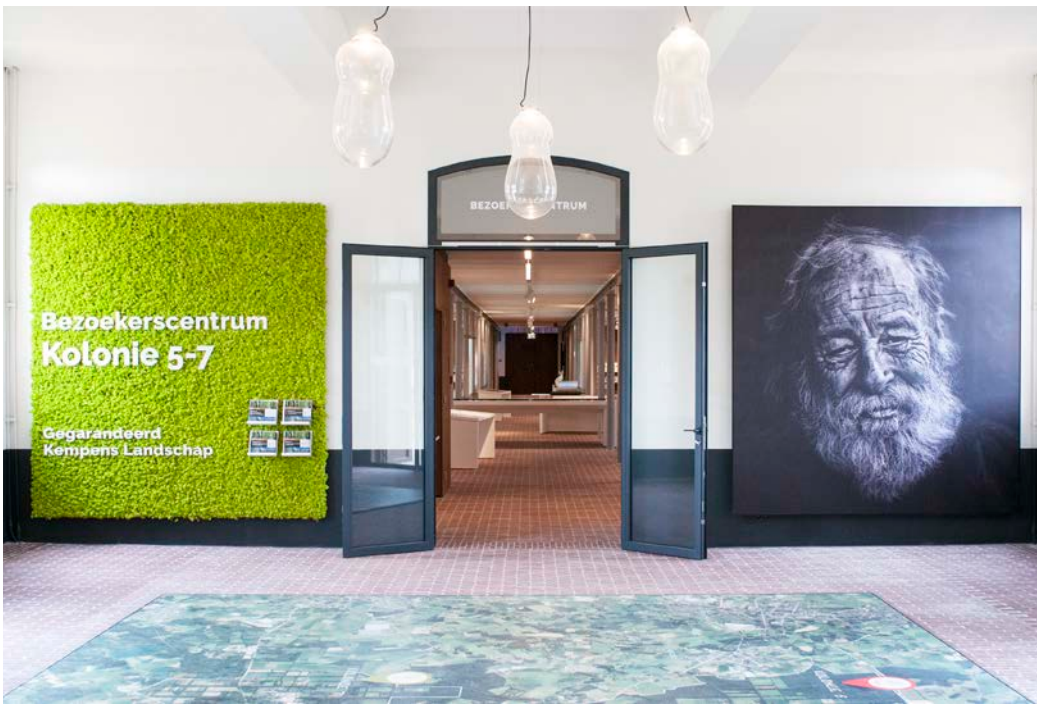


BRUNS
