Cinderella Table



One of the jewels of the 2012 Dutch Design Week was the Cinderella table by Rotterdam-based designers DEMAKERSVAN. The table is made from 57 layers of 13 layer multiplex. Initially, the table was designed entirely by computer. The layers were cut out bit by bit by a computer-controlled CNC router. After that, the 57 layers were stuck together and finished by hand.

Twenty-three copies of this work of art were created and can now be found all over the world. Some are owned by art lovers and others are on display at the Centre Pompidou in Paris and the Guggenheim museum in New York.
