The Provinciaal Hof in Bruges Belgium has reopened as the home of the West Fleming. It is an open house where everyone is welcome to discover all about the province and the rich history of the building itself. Including an interactive expo respecting the authentic elements of the more than 125-year-old building. Or a discovery tour that informs, inspires and teaches visitors something about the location.

Bruns was main contractor of the scenographic furniture for the new interactive expo. According to the design by FELT architecture & design, the spatial layout and technical realisation were executed. Prior to this, several test assemblies and mock-ups, were presented for approval. In addition, Bruns worked closely with Ocular to oversee the coordination and follow-up for multimedia integration.

Upon entering, visitors are welcomed on a large wooden counter. Further down the building, numerous new nooks have been created with typical objects. Presented in four different type of display cases with plinth and bell jar, on free-standing plinths and presentation plinths.

Information about the activities in the region are freely available via several tablets with listening horns and information kiosks. There is also a large model table with the map of West Flanders projected on it. Finally, a shop with a large display cabinet has been created on which authentic local products are presented.

The Provinciaal Hof is an accessible visitor centre for anyone interested in West-Flanders culture.
