



In the WOODlab visitors can get, in a contemporary and interactive way, acquainted with all aspects of wood. This ranges from sustainable building material that helps stabilize the climate, to microscopic secrets that explain the properties of wood.

By visiting the WOODlab, Botanical Garden Meise wants to fascinate people for the great 'invention' of nature that wood is. Wood is the most common product of living nature. It lives, it grows, it breathes, it adapts and it dies.

Bruns has created 4 interactive modules in the WOODlab. Module 1 is an exhibit, mounted on the table, where four graphic panels show the annual rings of a tree. Module 2 is an exhibit in which one learns more about the appearance of the different types of wood. Module 3 is an exhibit based on an electro game, in which the visitor must link different types of wood with the correct application. Module 4 is an exhibit with which the amount of moisture in wood can be demonstrated.
