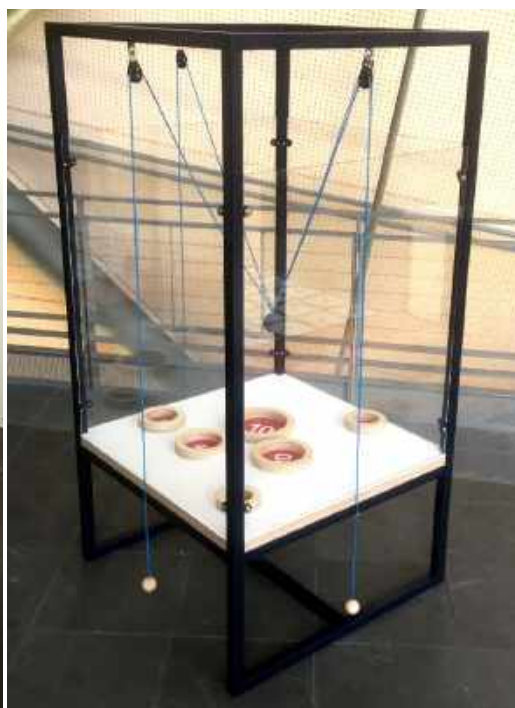

Idea No59 recognises a variety of emerging and unlocking technologies in three key areas:

- Resourceful Planet.

Within these three areas Bruns has realised several hands-on exhibits. The visitor discovers various skills such as: puzzling, memory, snake and playing 'butter cheese and eggs' against a robot.
